

# Congressional Flying Club & CAP Montgomery Senior Squadron Membership Information and Aircraft Fees

## Civil Air Patrol (CAP):

National Dues (as of FY2009)

**\$68.00 1<sup>st</sup> Year / \$58.00 Annually**

- All CFC Members must become CAP members for their first year of CFC membership. CFC members are not required to renew their CAP membership after the first year of CFC membership.

## Congressional Flying Club (CFC):

**Initiation Fee**

**\$700.00 One Time**

**Dues**

**\$63.00 Monthly**

**Work Hours**

**20 Per Year**

- One half of the initiation fee is refundable if the member terminates CFC membership prior to the end of the 6-month probationary period. After the probationary period, the initiation fee is non-refundable.
- CFC monthly dues are deducted from the member's account at the end of each month.
- ALL CFC members are REQUIRED to perform a minimum of 20 hours of maintenance, administrative or other approved work on club equipment or facilities per fiscal year (July 1 to June 30). These required hours are pro-rated from the time you join the club. Members WILL BE CHARGED \$40.00 per hour for every hour below the minimum 20 hours at the end of the fiscal year.

- Add **\$2.00** / tach hour if CFC account balance is below the minimum amount of \$120.
- Scheduling privileges are suspended if CFC account balance falls below \$50.
- Add **\$10.00** / tach hour if you are a primary student pilot until you receive your Private Pilot license.

## Aircraft Minimum Hours:

**These minimum charges apply if you reserve an aircraft from early morning to dusk.**

<b>Saturday:</b>	<b>4 hours</b>	<b>Weekend (Sat &amp; Sun):</b>	<b>6 hours</b>
<b>Sunday:</b>	<b>2 hours</b>	<b>Holiday Weekend (3 days):</b>	<b>8 hours</b>
<b>Holiday:</b>	<b>4 hours</b>	<b>Weekday:</b>	<b>0 hours</b>

- If you reserve an aircraft all day on a weekend or holiday and do not fly due to reasons other than weather and do not cancel before your reserved time, you MAY still be charged the minimum hours.
